We have seen the draft reports for the electricity PMO roles and structures and the PMR on the NT UC web site. We provided you with our inputs to the issues papers in relation to these and we have nothing more to add. We look forward to seeing the outcomes of these reports by the government.

With regard to the electricity Retail supply code, one of our main concerns was the ability of PWC to prevent competition by using the credit support criteria for generation. As we wrote in our letter of 1 August to you, our fears in the regard have been realised. On this basis, we do not consider the retail supply code as written to be appropriate and it needs revision to prevent PWC from using its position of dominance to prevent competition.
