## Electricity Reform Act 2000, Section 87 Exemption Document: Small Scale Renewable Energy Operations

- 1. Small Scale Renewable Energy Operations is defined as both:
  - (a) the generation of electricity where:
    - (i) the maximum generating capacity is two megawatts; and
    - (ii) the electricity is generated from a renewable source; and
    - (iii) the electricity is generated primarily for on-site supply; and
    - (iv) the generator is connected to the distribution network;

and

- (b) the associated sale of the excess electricity generated that is exported to the distribution network, when electricity is generated in excess of on-site supply requirements.
- 2. Pursuant to section 14(2) of the Act, a person carrying on these Operations is exempt from the need to hold a generation licence or a retail licence under section 14(1) of the Act by virtue of section 87 of the Act and this Exemption Document.
- 3. In accordance with section 87(1) of the Act, this exemption is subject to the following conditions:
  - (a) the exempt person must from time to time provide the Commission, in a manner and form to be determined by the Commission, such information as the Commission may request in the performance of its functions under any applicable laws;
  - (b) the total electricity generated from these Operations that is exported to the distribution network must be sold under contract to a licensed electricity retailer; and
  - (c) the exempt person must comply with all relevant safety and technical requirements of the Act and regulations.
- 4. Under section 87(3) of the Act, this exemption document, with the approval of the Minister, may be varied or revoked by the Commission by notice in writing.
- 5. This Exemption Document will continue until revoked.
