## **Fixing of Application Fees and Annual Licence Fees**

I, Eva Dina Lawler, Treasurer, with effect on 1 July 2024:

- (a) under sections 15(2) and 33(5) of the *Electricity Reform Act 2000*, fix the fee for an application under either of those sections to be 3 937 revenue units; being the amount I consider to be appropriate to meet the reasonable costs of determining an application; and
- (b) under section 19(3) of the Act, fix the annual licence fee for each financial year for a licence of a type specified in the Schedule to be:
  - (i) the amount specified opposite the type of licence in the Schedule, being the amount I consider to be a reasonable contribution towards administrative costs; or
  - (ii) for a licence that is granted part way through a year – a prorated amount of the fee mentioned in subparagraph (i).
