## RE: APPROVAL OF 2020-21 ANNUAL PRICING PROPOSAL FOR SYSTEM CONTROL AND MARKET OPERATOR CHARGES

Thank you for submitting the Power and Water Corporation's (PWC) 2020-21 Annual Pricing Proposal for System Control and Market Operator charges (2020-21 Pricing Proposal).

The Commission has assessed the 2020-21 Pricing Proposal and considers that it is compliant with the Commission's System Control Charges Final Decision for the 2019-20 to 2023-24 regulatory period.

As such, in accordance with section 39(2) of the *Electricity Reform Act 2000*, the Commission approves the 2020-21 system control charges to be applied by the power system controller from 1 July 2020 as set out in Table 1 below.

Table 1: 2020-21 approved System Control charges (nominal, excludes GST)

Component	2020-21
System control (\$/kWh)	0.0055
Market operator (\$/kWh)1	0.00059

The charges approved for 2020-21 are the maximum that PWC can charge for services provided by the power system controller with respect to its regulated electricity networks.
