Re: Electricity Industry Performance Code – Independent Compliance Audit Guidelines – EDL NGD (NT) Pty Ltd submission

EDL has reviewed the proposed Independent Compliance Audit Guidelines (Guidelines) to be published in accordance with the Electricity Industry Performance Code (EIP Code) and the *Utilities Commission Act 2000 (NT)*, as described in the letter from the Utilities Commission dated 16 June 2020.

In response, EDL is supportive of the proposed Guidelines and makes the following comments:

- 1) Regarding developing the auditing scope to address clause 6.1.1(a) of the EIP Code, EDL requests consideration as to how an auditor will assess the influence of the volatility of natural resources (i.e. irradiance data) on the performance indicators.
- 2) With reference to section 4.1.5, EDL requests that if the Commission considers an electricity entity has not nominated a suitable independent auditor, then the Commission shall provide justification as to why the auditor is not suitable.
