

2025-26 PRIORITIES

In accordance with its Strategic Plan 2025-2027, the Commission plans to deliver the following specific priorities for 2025-26:

- monitor licensees' compliance with regulatory obligations including ensuring internal and independent audits of compliance, as appropriate
- publish an annual report of electricity supply, water supply and sewerage services licensees' compliance with obligations
- complete stage 3 of the Commission's review of the Territory electricity supply industry licensing regime
- publish annual reports on power system and retail performance, and an assessment of the demand and supply outlook
- complete the current review of the Electricity Industry Performance Code
- publish an annual price monitoring report for the Port of Darwin
- deliver the Commission's annual report to the Minister regarding any material instances of non-compliance with the private port operator's access policy and determinations made by the Commission
- continue to provide advice to the Territory government as appropriate, including in relation to Territory electricity market reforms, economic regulation of water and sewerage services reforms and the planned Darwin ship lift access and pricing regulatory regime
- meet regularly with stakeholders, including site visits where possible
- identify, and have staff participate in, relevant professional development.
